Level 1

This class introduces dance basics and inspires young dancers to express themselves through movement, developing their understanding of the art and technique of dance in an atmosphere of fun and purpose. Students will learn the joys of their connection with various stories and their characters. Children are encouraged to participate in class, but are not forced to do so. For the child that is apprehensive about participating, we encourage them to watch until they become more comfortable.

As each child develops differently, patience on the part of the parents, as well as the child is stressed. Our goal is to prepare the children to be more independent when they reach preschool age. Tiny Tots do not perform a dance in our recital.

Appropriate dance attire includes a **pink leotard** and tights, and pink ballet shoes (color: female; pink or male; black). Hair should be pulled back in a ponytail.

Level 2

Creative Combo is a Pre- Ballet/ movement and tap based class focusing on fundamental dance moves, major motor skills, rhythm, and coordination. Children in these classes will learn basic dance steps, as well as how to take turns, learn to count music, take direction from a teacher, and participate in a specialized classroom setting.

Students will be introduced to the fundamentals of tap terminology. One of the main goals of this class is for them to use dance manners, take turns and work on listening skills. child to begin to gain independence and self confidence!

They perform a ballet and tap dance in the recital.

Appropriate dance attire includes a **light blue** leotard and tights, and pink ballet shoes (color: female; pink or male; black) and black tap shoes. Hair should be pulled back in a ponytail or a bun.

Saturday 9:30-10:15 am (7:00 Recital)

Level 3

Kidlets is a creative movement pre-ballet and tap class focusing on fundamental dance moves, major motor skills, rhythm, and coordination.

Children in these classes will learn basic dance steps, as well as how to take turns, learn to count music, take direction from a teacher, and participate in a specialized classroom setting.

Students will be introduced to the fundamentals of tap terminology. The lessons will advance their musicality and rhythm.

They will perform a ballet and tap dance in recital.

Appropriate dance attire includes a **lavender** leotard and tights, and pink ballet shoes (color: female; pink or male; black) and black tap shoes. Hair should be pulled back in a ponytail or a bun.

Monday 5:00-5:45 (1:00 Recital)

Saturday 10:15-11:00 (7:00 Recital)

Level 4

The 5-6 yr. Combo Class begins the year with focus on following directions. Throughout the year, children will be introduced to new dance steps, which become more challenging as the year progresses. In addition, children will also learn to count music.

The year concludes with an emphasis on memorization of simple dance steps and combinations.

They will perform a ballet and tap class in the recital.

Appropriate dance attire includes a **navy blue** leotard and tights, and pink ballet shoes (color: female; pink or male; black) and black tap shoes. Hair should be pulled back in a ponytail or a bun

Tuesday 5:00-6:00 (1:00 Recital)

Saturday 11:00-12:00 (7:00 Recital)

Level 5

For 6-9 year olds, they will learn fundamental ballet, tap and jazz skills. The year begins with focus on following directions.

Throughout the year, children will be introduced to new dance steps, which become more challenging as the year progresses.

They can choose 2 or 3 genres, but must have ballet. They will perform a dance in the recital for each style of dance they are taking.

Appropriate dance attire includes a **black leotard** and tights, and pink ballet shoes (color: female; pink or male; black), black tap shoes and dark tan jazz shoes. Hair should be pulled back in a ponytail or bun (preferable).

BALLET: Tuesday 6:30-7:00 (1:00 Recital); Saturday 9:30-10:00 (7:00 Recital)

What does tuition include?

Tuition includes the following:

- *Tuition is based on 10 equal installments, which is paid monthly (this is not a monthly fee, but installment). If you start after September, the tuition will be higher based upon when you register.
- *ALL Recital costumes which range from on average \$75 & up based on size, etc. (depending on class; this could be anywhere from 1-3 costumes and accessories per class and this monthly installment plan helps from having to pay for costumes around the holidays, and for those who need sometime 6+ costumes, this is a HUGE help!)
- *tights (this is anywhere from 1-3 or more pairs)
- *recital t-shirt
- *4 recital vouchers per dancer (regardless if they are in one recital or both)
- *recital fee (this is the cost of putting on a production, theatre rental, etc)
- * 2 full color program books per dancer
- * free recital recording
